## Your Itinerary:

### WED. MAY 9

Depart East Lyme and New London by motorcoach to the airport for our overnight flight to Lisbon.

### THUR. MAY 10

We arrive Lisbon in the morning and check into our hotel. Tonight meet your tour director for a welcome dinner with wine at our hotel. (D)

### FRI. MAY 11- LISBON

Today, sightseeing with a local guide features a drive through the Baixa quarter's main squares. Drive along the grand Avenida da Liberdade up to Pombal Square and stop for pictures of Belem Tower and Monument of the Discoverers. Also visit Jeronimos Monastery with the tomb of Vasco da Gama. (B)

### SAT. May 12 – LISBON-OBIDOS-ALCOBACA-NAZARE-FATIMA-TOMAR

Stop in medieval Obidos and go back in time as you walk along the narrow streets. Continue to Alcobaca and visit the Church of Santa Maria Monastery. See the elaborate tombs of King Pedro I and his Castilian lover, Ines de Castro. In the afternoon, Fatima's Sanctuary of our Lady of the Rosary. Overnight in Tomar. (B,D)

### SUN. MAY 13 – TOMAR – CONIMBRIGA – COIMBRA – OPORTO

Visit the hilltop Convent of Christ with its famous Manueline Window. Farther north, the Roman Ruins of Conimbriga. Tour the excavations, admire the well-preserved mosaics and visit the museum. Continue to Coimbra and visit the gilded baroque library of its 700 year old university. Overnight in Oporto, Portugal's second largest city. (B)

### MON. MAY 14 – OPORTO

Sightseeing includes a panoramic drive to the mouth of the Douro River, the richly decorated Church of Sao Francisco and the stock exchange with its contemporary Arabian Hall. Visit the famous Sandeman & Co. Port Wine Cellar to taste the port wine produced from grapes of the Douro Valley. (B)

### TUES. MAY 15 – OPORTO – GUIMARAES – VILA REAL- VISEU

In Guimaraes, enjoy a walk through the medieval center of the "Cradle of Portugal". Visit the splendid gardens and enjoy tapas and wine at the Quinta da Aveleda Winery. Tonight a special dinner with local specialties and wine at Forno da Mimi restaurant. (B, D)

### WED. MAY 16 – VISEU-BELMONTE-CASTELO DE VIDE-EVORA

In Belmonte, a visit to the Jewish Museum and an olive oil tasting, for which this area is famous. This afternoon in Castelo de Vide to walk through the Jewish quarter with its white-washed houses and its medieval synagogue. Before arriving in Evora, the cultural center of southern Portugal we visit a cork factory, (B, D)

### THUR. MAY 17 – EVORA –ALGARVE

A massive wall surrounds Evora's medieval center, a UNESCO World Heritage site. A walking tour through its narrow alleys to the Roman Temple, Portas de Moura fountain and Sao Francisco church. Visit the Ossuary Chapel, whose walls are covered with thousands of human bones and skulls. Tonight In Algarve, Portugal's most popular vacation area. (B)

### FRI. MAY 18 –ALGARVE COASTAL EXCURSION

Highlight today is a visit to Promontory of Sagres, where Henry the Navigator lived. Next stop at Cape St. Vincent and pretty Lagos before returning to hotel. (B)

### SAT. MAY 19 –ALGARVE-AZEITAO-LISBON

Take the scenic route over the Serra da Arrabida and savor views of the Troia Peninsula. Catch glimpses of the castle at Sesimbra and visit Azeitao to visit a traditional tile workshop. After crossing the Bridge of April 25th, you're back in Lisbon. Tonight, enjoy a spectacular view at Varanda restaurant for our farewell dinner. (B, D)

### SUN. MAY 20 – LISBON-HOME

Breakfast at our hotel then transfer to airport for our flight home and motorcoach to East Lyme and New London.
